EXTENSION OF MACHINGA EPL

Resource Star Limited (ASX:RSL) announces that the Minister of Natural Resources, Energy and Environment has granted an aerial extension to Machinga EPL.

The Company makes this announcement in conjunction with the Company's JV partner, Globe Metals and Mining Limited (ASX:GBE). This extension will add a number of interesting new Geophysical targets for future works for Resource Star Limited.

In 2009, Resource Star signed a joint venture agreement with Globe over its Machinga Project, with Globe managing the work and currently earning 20% equity through exploration expenditure. In a staged process, Globe can earn up to 80% in the project by funding all activity up to and including a feasibility study.
