



## RESOURCE STAR LIMITED - FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q. I've just received a letter from Resource Star Limited regarding my entitlement to shares. I don't own any shares in Resource Star. Why have I received this letter?
- A. If you were a shareholder in Gowings Retail Limited (former code GBR on the Australian Stock Exchange), you automatically became a shareholder in its successors G Retail Limited and Retail Star Limited. Following overwhelming shareholder approval, Retail Star Limited changed its name on 14 July 2008, to become **Resource Star Limited**.
- Q. I can't access the RSL code through E\*Trade or Commsec. They tell me that the code doesn't exist.
- A. During July and August 2008, Resource Star Limited (ASX:RSL) is undergoing a share consolidation. When there is corporate action such as share consolidation, where the shares are trading on a deferred settlement basis under the deferred settlement code (RSLDA), the link to the announcements is not available. E\*Trade are aware of the issue and are looking into this matter. In the meantime, Company Announcements can be accessed through the "Prices, Research & Announcements" section of the ASX website ([www.asx.com.au](http://www.asx.com.au)) or through RSL's website ([www.resourcestar.com.au](http://www.resourcestar.com.au)).
